

How to pray for our missionaries

Here are some ideas of things you can pray about for each missionary. Having their newsletters with current updates can also help your prayers be more specific.

Pray for their –

Relationship with God: Loving and studying God's Word, strong prayer life, be filled with the Holy Spirit, maturing spiritually, progress over personal sin.

Physical and emotional needs: Adaptation to climate, health in the midst of disease, safety in danger, victory over loneliness and depression.

Family relationships: Husband/wife, children/parents, family life as a model to nationals, coping with singleness, family stressors back home.

Ability to communicate: Language study, continual improvement in fluency, cultural adaptation/understanding.

Effective ministry: Teaching, preaching, witnessing, boldness, open doors, prepared hearts, fruitfulness.

Team relationships: Other missionaries, national evangelists, pastors, teachers, peace between team members.

Country and people group: Evangelization of the people group, government (national and local), political situation, visas, continued open door, outreach to cities, villages, and tribal areas.

How can you pray for missions at KPC?

Join KPCers from home by using this prayer book during your daily devotions throughout the year.

Participate in P-31 (Prayer for 31 days). This prayer initiative is perfect for you if you can't attend a weekly prayer meeting! You can sign up to come pray in the chapel at a time and day that is convenient to you. We aim to have one person signed up each day of the month so our missionaries are getting prayed for at least one hour a day. You can pray alone, or bring friends and family to pray with you. The chapel is set up with current prayer requests and other aids to help you know how and what to pray for. Contact Rachel to sign up for your hour!
